However, in more recent years, new services like rehabilitation have been added to numerous facilities. Normally, someone who has just undergone surgery, such as a knee or hip replacement, will stay in a skilled nursing facility for a few months or weeks, depending on the requirements of their rehabilitation. Major operations, like for example joint replacements, will be very hard for most people to care for at home, especially if they live by themselves. A skilled nursing facility provides 24 hour care and physical therapy in an environment that is safe and is intended to house people with disabilities.
