Retirement Residences Armstrong - It can be very stressful to enter into a new phase of life. Moving into an assisted care facility is one which entails such drastic changes. Much of what one's lifestyle would look like in the future is not known and can lead to high levels of fear and resistance against moving out of one's house into an assisted living situation.

Each and every possible resident must be assessed prior to moving into an assisted living facility to ensure that the person's existing requirements could be met and that the facility is suitable. Fees for assisted living are usually determined by a base rate in addition to fees for needed services. Occasionally there is a fee per service, that is just added to the resident's monthly bill. Other times there could be a flat rate per month based on the level of help which was determined during the initial assessment. Assistance services often include things like for example help with getting dressed, grooming, toileting or bathing, assistance with transfers, and management of the person's medications.

When looking for an appropriate facility, make sure to schedule for a short term visit before committing. This is the only way to get an idea of what life will be like within the community or facility. It not possible to experience all aspects of the community from a short term visit, but it is the best way to get a general sense of the environment and whether or not the facility would remain on the list of candidates.

Assisted living facilities offer a huge array of amenities and services, so it is always a good idea to research each facility to see if what they offer fits with the desires and requirements of the individual. In addition, the needed level of assistance at each stage of life can change, so searching for a facility which can adapt to potentially changing needs is great. Though not as common, there are existing facilities that offer assisted living as well as nursing care. These are normally called continuing care facilities and they are a great option for people who would not like to transfer into completely different facilities every time their level of need increases.

The kind of housing, the number of residents and the amenities and services which are provided by assisted living facilities differ greatly. Residents can reside in separate houses, or they can reside in apartments which may be studios, one bedroom, or two bedroom units. Within assisted living facilities residents can enter and leave the facility whenever they want. Even though several units may have small kitchenettes for preparing snacks and simple meals, meals are normally served in shared dining halls and residents normally have a choice of meals from a menu. Assisted living facilities have other common places like for instance pools, libraries, activity rooms, fitness centres, and even hair salons. Having many common areas encourages residents to interact more with each other. Visitors are permitted and are usually required to just sign in at the front desk. Outside of normal business hours doors might be locked, so guests might need to be let in by security.
